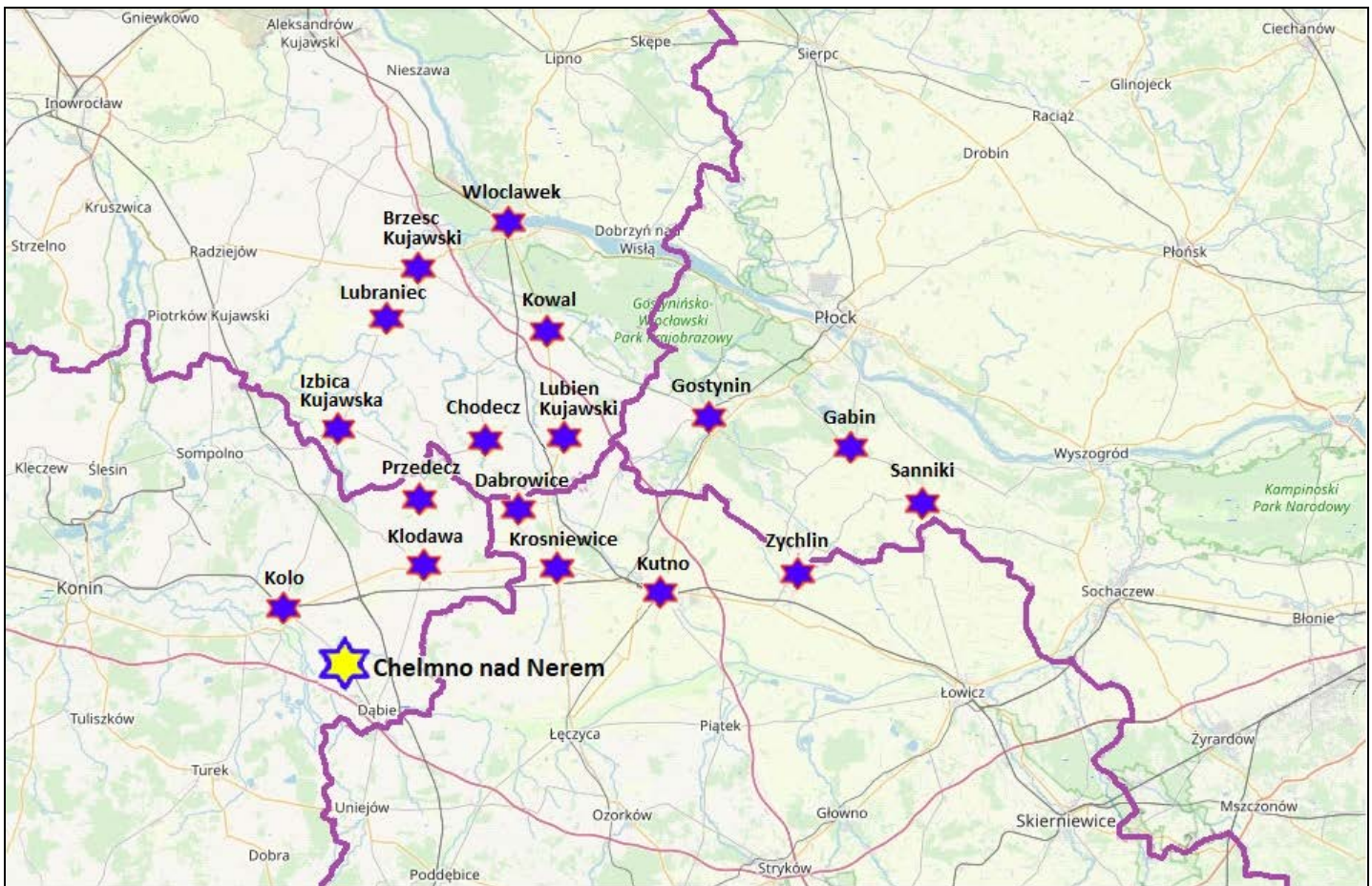


The shtetls of Jewish Central Poland

Jewish Central Poland encompasses the Jewish communities that existed before the Second World War in the area where the four central provinces of contemporary Poland converge: Wielkopolska, Kujawy-Pomerania, Mazovia, and Ziemia Łódzka.



In its initial phase, the ADJCP - Association of Descendants of Jewish Central Poland will be mainly focused on the 17 towns that will be visited in the Spring of 2022 to commemorate the 80th anniversary of the liquidation of the region's ghettos and the murder of the Jews at Chelmino extermination camp.
