

Jewish Central Poland (JCP) is defined here as encompassing the Jewish communities that existed before the Second World War in the area where the four central provinces of contemporary Poland converge: Wielkopolska, Kujawy-Pomerania, Mazovia, and Ziemia Łódzka. Most of the Jewish families from those communities were killed at Chelmno nad Nerem at the hands of the Nazis.
